Distinguished Alumni Awards (DAAs) - 2025

Nominations are invited from eligible Alumni of MNREC/MNNIT Allahabad for Distinguished Alumni Awards (DAAs) – 2025 in different categories as per the details given below. The last date of submitting the application through Google form is May 15, 2025.

There are eight (08) categories of Awards (Non-financial) as given below:

Number, type and offers in the awards.

- 1) Distinguished Moti – Lifetime Achievement Award (Age 60 years or above)
- 2) Distinguished Moti – Young Achiever Award in Male & Female Category, separately (Age below 40 years)
- 3) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Private, Corporate and Industry sector (Age above 40 Years)
- 4) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Public administration / Public sector (Age above 40 Years)
- 5) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Academics and Research sector (Age above 40 Years)
- 6) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Entrepreneurship and Innovation (Age above 40 Years)
- 7) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Service to Alma mater and Society (Age above 40 Years)
- 8) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – International Service / Recognition (Age above 40 Years)

Timelines (As decided by Selection-cum-Search Committee)

- 1) Detailed advertisement of the DAAs call via various social media platforms and else by March 15, 2025
- 2) Period of online applications till May 15, 2025
- 3) Scrutiny of applications by August 31, 2025
- 4) Announcement of award winners – September 10, 2025
- 5) Awards distribution – November-December 2025 preferably during Global Alumni Convention (GAC-2025)

Guidelines and selection criteria for different distinguished awards

The following alumni are *not eligible* to receive an Alumni Award:

- Alumni who currently hold political office at a local, provincial/state, or national level.
- Members of the Alumni awards selection committee.
- Office bearers of the Alumni Association Executive Committee.

Conditions of Nomination

- Nominees must be graduates of the MNREC/MNNIT Allahabad in a recognized Bachelors, Masters or Doctoral program. **He/She must be registered with web portal of MNNIT Alumni Association (MAA) before nomination. Nominations of non-registered Alumni will not be considered.**
- Nominees must be in good standing in the community who have not been engaged in activities that could bring dishonour to MNREC/MNNIT Allahabad.
- Nominations must be submitted according to the guidelines applicable for that year.
- An individual may receive an award in more than one category during their lifetime, but may be honoured in only one category in a single year.
- Nominations can be made by MNREC/MNNIT Allahabad alumni, staff, faculty, students.
- Nominators must contact the individual prior to submitting their nomination package to confirm the following:
 - The individual agrees to be nominated.

- The nominee understands that their selection is contingent on being available to attend the Celebration of Excellence to accept the award in person (unless in an emergency, after due approval of the awards committee).
- All nominations will be treated as strictly confidential.
- Nominations received after the closing date will not be accepted.
- Alumni may nominate themselves i.e. self-nomination is allowed.
- The Selection-cum-Search Committee may also nominate the candidates in different categories but before the evaluation stage i.e. up to the last date of nomination.
- A person/candidate can apply or may be nominated in maximum two categories of awards. Also, the DAA committee may consider the nominee in one more categories with due consent of the nominee, if the candidate's nomination is in a single category.
- If any applicant/ nominee is not selected for any award in any year he/she will be eligible to apply again next time.

Eligibility Criteria

1) Distinguished Moti – Lifetime Achievement Award

- ✓ The alumnus should be 60 years of age or above at the time of nomination.
- ✓ The criterion would be Excellence in the Service to Society.
- ✓ Outstanding contributions that made a transformative impact within their community.
- ✓ Exemplary achievement throughout their lifetime.
- ✓ Service to MNREC/MNNIT Allahabad, Contribution in strengthening MAA.

2) Distinguished Moti – Young Achiever Award in Male & Female categories separately.

(Distinguished Young Achiever Award for Professional Excellence for Young Alumni age less than or equal to 40 years on the last date of application).

- ✓ Young Innovator/Incubator
- ✓ Industry/Entrepreneurial excellence
- ✓ Academic and Research Excellence

3) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Private, Corporate and Industry sector

- ✓ Established known startups/Industries
- ✓ Holding a reputed post/highest post

4) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Public administration / Public sector

- ✓ Perform excellent administrative duties in the public domain
- ✓ Holding a reputed/high post

5) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Academics and Research sector

- ✓ Outstanding, innovative activity in the form of patents, research papers and projects.

6) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Entrepreneurship and Innovation

- ✓ Outstanding, innovative activity in business, industry, and labour relations.

7) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – Service to Alma mater and Society

- ✓ Highest fund contributor of the year to the MNREC/MNNITA Alumni corpus fund
- ✓ Establishing the state-of-the-art laboratories in MNREC/MNNITA
- ✓ Alumnus providing higher number of placement and training to MNREC/MNNITA students

8) Distinguished Moti – Professional Excellence – International Service / Recognition

- ✓ Outstanding, innovative activity in international relations and service.
- ✓ Awarded by the international organisation /foreign country
